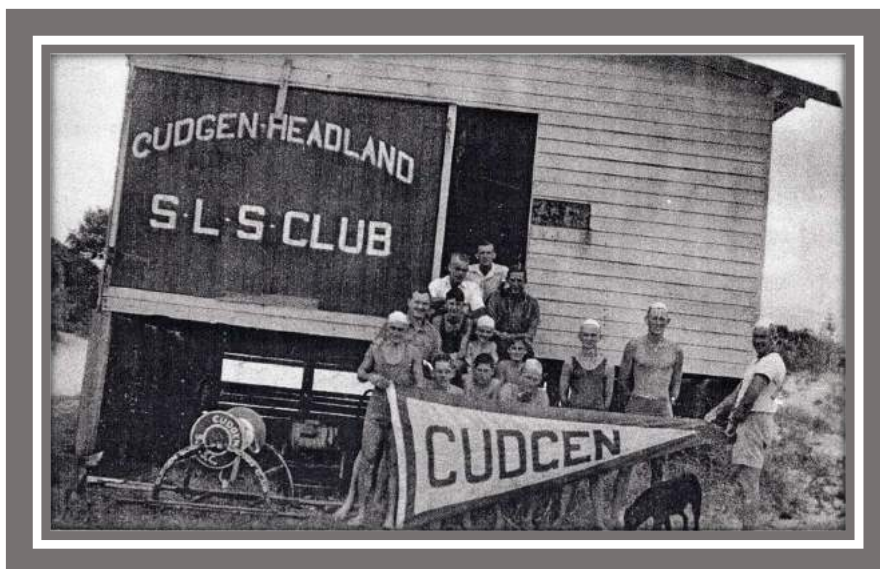
### Mission Statement

# PRESIDENT'S REPORT

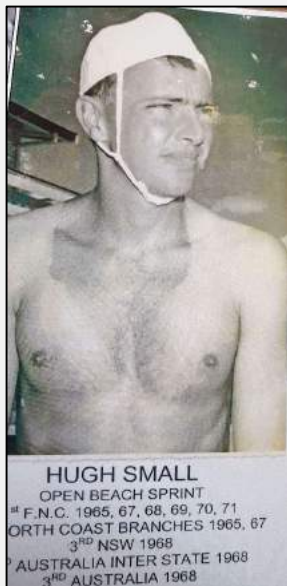
This season the club welcomed a number of fresh faces into some of the Standing Committee positions and with their appointment came some new ideas and a renewed enthusiasm.

## Surfsports

The club had very strong results at all levels of Surfsports with our athletes competing and medalling at local, country state and Aussie championships. Jules Loemker' win in the Australian U15 Male board race was a dominating performance and we are excited to see what results our young athletes can produce as we build toward the World Championships which are being held on the Gold Coast in August 2024.

We had good representation in a number of representative team events this season with athletes being selected in the FNC Branch Interbranch Team, the Tran-Tasman series and the Super Surf League team competitions. Thank you to those that assisted with hosting the Trans-Tasman series and volunteering their time to assist with one of the teams.



The clubs' results at this year SLSNSW State championships held at Queenscliff were our best results on record. Our athletes, like many of the athletes from the other Far North Coast Branch Clubs, thrived in the big surf conditions and came home with 23 medals from U9-Open. The other pleasing result was the high amount of 4th, 5th, 6th places and finalists that we had which bodes well for the future. The juniors had a team in all 6 Cameron relay finals which demonstrates the quality of athletes that we continue to produce

We extend our thanks to our dedicated coaching staff Scott McCartney and Stephen George who have invested an enormous amount of time assisting our competitors and we look forward to welcoming our next crop of future super stars as they transition from to junior movement into the senior ranks next season.

Many thanks to the officials for their perseverance this season in the delivery of a range of carnivals from Branch through to Aussies. They put in an enormous amount of volunteer hours at their own cost to ensure that our athletes can compete.



## Junior Activities Committee (JAC)



Greg Brown did a fantastic job of leading a fresh JAC committee this season and building on the legacy left from the last three years by Paul Burdekin and his team. The committee delivered a well-structured training and activity program resulting in an increase in the skill level of each age group throughout the season. # GENERAL MANAGERS REPORT

2022-2023 began with our 100 Year Celebrations at the Club and Twin Towns Services Club Gala dinner – thanks to everyone involved as it was a great success and a wonderful milestone.

Looking back over my notes we were still being impacted by above average rainfall in the beginning of the year and luckily this subsided as did the impact of the Covid pandemic – staffing is returning to normal although skilled Kitchen Staff remain in high demand. At times during the year, we were unable to operate our Bistro normally and reverted to using Food Trucks to supplement our offer but thankfully the situation is improving gradually. In addition, our forward Functions Bookings are extremely healthy, and Zinc Café continues to trade well in a very crowded marketplace.

In regard to the building, we completed much of the renovation's downstairs, improving craft storage capacity and creating the new Multipurpose room. Fire protection work has continued, a walk in freezer installed upstairs and complete revamp of the Training room ( Board Room ) enabling more Corporate usage and a more comfortable learning space. Lifesaving education storage and office areas upstairs were also renovated, and recently a new 'clip lock ' roof installed and 167 panel Solar system replaced entirely using a N.S.W. Government Grant of \$220,000.00. We save around \$3,000.00 per month as a result of the 70Kw solar system.

Recently it became apparent our Liquor Licensing situation regarding the accuracy of upstairs plans and using the grassed area in front of the Club needed updating, hence we were unable to use the grass space for Anzac Day, Barefoot Bars and other events throughout the year. This is being rectified as quickly as possible and hopefully will be reinstated quickly.

Combine this Financial position with ongoing maintenance, renovation and equipment replacement, I feel the Club is well positioned.

# DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATION

It is with great pleasure that I submit my fourth Annual Report to the Cudgen Headland membership for consideration.

After the challenges of COVID throughout the last seasons, the SLSNSW Board made the decision in September 2022 to rescind the controversial Vaccination Mandate for frontline surf lifesaving activities.

This season saw the introduction of mandatory “Child Safe Awareness Training” across the State for various office bearers and other positions including;

- Officers on Club Executive Committees
- Patrol Captains and Vice Patrol Captains
- Junior Activity Chairs and Age Managers
- Surf Sports Coaches and Officials
- Trainers, Assessors and Facilitators
- MPIOs and Complaints Managers

The completion rate of the mandatory training has been high and appears the updated training has been well accepted across the organisation since it was introduced.

In the administration space, our Club has met all of its reporting obligations as a Not for Profit entity as well as a surf lifesaving Club affiliated with Far North Coast Branch, Surf Life Saving NSW, Surf Life Saving Australia as well as the Australian Charities and Not-for-Profits Commission.

Thank you to the ongoing commitment and hard work across the season from our Administration Manager Margaret Cargnoni, who’s position continues to grow.

I would like to thank the other Board members for their assistance throughout the season including Adam Mills, Paul Burdekin, Matthew Bell, Erin Kill, Mark Humphries, Susan Eke, Greg Brown.

Thank you also to Mike Crawley for committing to the Chairpersons role for the season.

Thank you also to all of our standing committees and sub committees across the Club for their tireless work throughout the season keeping their various sections operating.

Thank you to our amazing sponsors and donors that continue to support our wonderful Club and the surf lifesaving movement.

On behalf of Cudgen Headland and our members I would like to recognise the following contributions;

- The NSW Government through the Emergency Services portfolio for ongoing funding of state-

wide operations and programs which benefit clubs, members and the community.

- Through the NSW Government’s Office of Sport Surf Club Facilities Grant Programme 2022/2023, The NSW Premier, The Minister for the Office of Sport as well as Mr Geoffrey Provest State Member for Tweed for funding to assist with the new surf club roof (\$194,980.00 ex GST).
- The NSW Deputy Premier and Mr Geoffrey Provest State Member for Tweed for funding from the Regional NSW Community Grant for our mobile board racking project (\$20,000.00 ex GST).
- The Tweed Shire Council for funding from the 2022-2023 Events Sponsorship Programme for the 2023 Australian IRB Championships, which will be hosted in July 2023 (\$15,000.00 ex GST).
- SLSNSW for funding in the 2022 Club Lifesaving Equipment Grant (\$2,336.98).

# DIRECTOR OF FINANCE

It's a pleasure to be providing a financial update for CHSLSC in respect to the 2022/23 financial year ending April 2023. I must firstly thank Trudi Tesch for creating such a smooth transition for me into the Director of Finance role. As Trudi indicated last year, business processes, procedures and structures had been developed to ensure a strong platform for future operations, along with our regulatory and compliance requirements – and myself and the broader financial team have benefited from that work.

The 2022/23 financial year saw the club step out of the shadow cast by COVID, and for the most part return to normal operational levels. Pleasingly this has resulted in further strengthening of our financial position, as reflected in our balance sheet, which has our equity position \$256,888 stronger than at the same time this year.

However, whilst things were mostly normal – outcomes generated certainly did not come without a lot of hard work and effort, and some challenges that remain in the broader economy following the COVID period. We are incredibly fortunate to have great people leading, guiding and volunteering across the entire club – and the strength of the financial outcome is down to every one of you – so thank you.

There are several people that are deserving of special thanks. The club is fortunate to have an in-house finance and administration team who are excellent at what they do, allowing us to manage the vast majority of our financial requirements internally. To Sue Gornall and Margaret Cargnoni – huge thanks for all that goes in to ensuring the back end of the club is so well looked after. In the finance space, Sue is incredibly well supported when needed by Julia Lamb, Lauren Arthur (Accountant - Simmons Partnership) and David Alcock (Auditor – Integrated Audit Services).

As everyone is aware, we run a sectional model. Finances are aggregated at a consolidated level, however each section has their own budgets and financial objectives aligned to the delivery of their functional area. This promotes strong accountability, some great conversations, excellent oversight and ownership of outcomes – along with a few frustrations as to who pays for what and why! Despite these occasional frustrations, it's a model that I would suggest works well, with great thanks to the sectional leaders and their respective treasury roles. In that vein I would like to pay thanks to Jenny Waters who looks after Lifesaving and Surf Sports finances, and goes above and beyond to ensure we are managing things with care and attention to detail. I would also like to thank Trudy Ray (Coldies) and Deb Arghyros (JAC) for their help.

Within the sections, things remain in good shape. The year saw a review of the majority of the asset base within SLS and ensure it aligns with the useful life of the respective items. Thanks to all involved in completing this. We benefitted throughout the year from donations and sponsorship of \$107k. We are grateful for, and thank those donors and sponsors who continue to recognise the role CHSLSC plays in the community. Special thanks also to Mark Humphries who does a magnificent job ensuring those donors and sponsors are connected to the club and our appreciation is conveyed. Additionally, thanks goes to all those who help with fundraising across the Club, from those who donate prizes for raffles, to the team that runs Trivia every Tuesday, all the way to Warren and Christine Boyd who manage all the SurfSports raffles – it all helps and is all very much appreciated – so a big thank you to all involved.

I would like to recognise the F&B team, lead superbly by Greg Swift with the support of Mick Fabris and Adam Gane. The team delivered a record revenue year, with sales of \$3,944,850, a lift of \$878,400 on the prior year. Within this, Zinc Café generated sales of \$487,677 and continues to grow as it becomes a more established part of the community. These outcomes are outstanding and have largely contributed to the strengthening of our balance sheet. As mentioned above, this result was not achieved without a huge amount of work under circumstances that were not particularly easy. Post COVID there remains a hangover in supply chain and the employment market, which along with price pressure across the majority of the cost base has had to be navigated. Well done and thank you to Greg and the broader team for delivering these results.

Our outlook for the FY23/24 year is good. The year has started well, with revenues continuing to grow, though cost pressures remain. As Trudi eluded in her report last year, the Board has turned attention to the building, and how we navigate from our existing building to something that will service the Kingscliff community for 2050. A committee is soon to be formed to lead these efforts, and updates and opportunities for discussion will flow throughout the year as we progress those plans. Whilst we are doing



that, we continue to invest back into the existing building. You will note deferred income of \$85,791 in the year, which relates to a grant received for the replacement of the roof. This work has been complete, with the grant soon to be acquitted.

Lastly, I wish to thank all the Directors for their support and collaboration across the year.

Our Auditors and Accountants have issued their report which is contained within. Should you have any

# LIFESAVING TREASURER'S REPORT

A key financial characteristic of the 22-23 Patrolling Season was generosity at the local level. Cudgen Headland SLSC's sponsors, donors, club patrons, local businesses and members acknowledged with their generosity the value to the community of delivering essential front line lifesaving services between the red and yellow patrol flags on our beautiful Kingscliff Beach and surrounding waterways.

Local fundraising and the provision of volunteer water safety services are both key elements of surf club life. The 57<sup>th</sup> Annual Car Raffle was again a sell out in 2023 (see The 57<sup>th</sup> Car Raffle Report) and Trivia Night proved once more to be an 'Oldie but a Goodie'. Volunteer water safety services are mutually beneficial as a training operation and a vital source of cash to support recurring operating expenses.

The Australian Government through SLSA and the NSW Government via SLSNSW provided funding to surf clubs as Emergency Service Agents to purchase and maintain vital water safety equipment to assist in saving lives. Ongoing pledges from The Guardians of the Surf throughout Australia and donations of equipment from the 'Anonymous Donor' were gratefully received at the surf club level. Government grants received to fund capital works are recognised elsewhere in this annual report.

Big ticket donated critical surf lifesaving acquisitions during the year included a new John Deere Tractor (The McIntosh Family) and a Can-Am SSV (Anonymous Donor and Australian Government).

Surf Lifesaving continues to provide financial support to Surf Sports. This assistance is necessary to fund our club coach and the thriving competitive program. It represents an investment in the sustainability of voluntary patrolling members required to deliver best practice in aquatic rescue.

The role of providing financial control over Surf Lifesaving funds at Cudgen Headland SLSC is rewarding. It is a pleasure to serve as a member of the committee under the directorship of Matt Bell. The committee has a wealth of lifesaving expertise and enthusiasm. Finally, thank you to the quiet workers who fulfil essential roles that enable an efficient Surf Lifesaving treasury function – you know who you are!

# PATROL MANAGER'S REPORT

To all those who contributed in some way to our beach patrols during the 2022/23 season, please accept our gratitude and thanks. This season we had 13 patrol teams led by the following Patrol Captains, Barracudas – Sue Eke, Crabs – Nick Forde, Dolphins – Gav Smith, Ducks – Andrew Mills, Flying Fish – Cody Bell, Hammerheads – Michael Kenny, Manta Rays – Hayley Smith, Mermaids – Alex Torrance & Susan Young, Mulletts – Simon Tate, Old Salts – David Rope, Prawns – Tim Regan, Seagulls – Doug Fewtrell & Whales – Janthea Andersen. In addition, the patrols were assisted by our Active Reserves.

It was a massive season, in fact one of our biggest on record, with the following Cudgen statistics compared with SLSNSW overall results.

Of the 25 rescues we performed, 18 were with rescue boards. Of our 33 First Aid cases, 3 required oxygen and 6 required an ambulance. Of the 514 hours we were rostered to patrol the beach, we closed the beach for 11 hours due to sharks or dangerous conditions.



Our volunteers patrolled the beach every weekend and public holiday from 24 September to 25 April, including the festive season – a total of 5,265 patrol person-hours. A special thank-you goes to the Hammerheads and Whales patrol teams for keeping our beach safe on Christmas day. In addition to our rostered patrols, our patrolling members supported many other events, such as Preschool visits, Rotary Kingscliff Duck Race, Uki Refugee Project, International Day of People Working With A Disability, Cudgen Classic, Trans Tasman Series, 2 Kingscliff Triathlons (50 competitors were assisted or rescued during the 2 triathlons) and the ANZAC Day Parade.

Congratulations and thanks to our patrolling members who carried-out 100% or more of their rostered patrol hours, namely Sven Loemker, Nick Forde, Greg Wood, Leya Nipperess, Derek Goodchild, Gav Smith, Sally Smith, Bev Ward, Cody Bell, Scott McCartney, Chloe Jones, Zayne Chisholm, Patrick Allsopp, Michael Kenny, Paul Ransom, Tony Strang, Paul Smith, Gregory Pile, Bek Napier, Linda Goodwin, Shar Merchant, Kasey Lloyd, Chevy (Shiana) Lewis, Simon Tate, Erin Kill, David Rope, Dennis Eyre, Richard Adams, Mark Humphries and Janthea Andersen.

Due to the generosity of our sponsors, we were able to keep our life saving equipment up to date and in particular, replace the tractor and one of the SSVs (beach vehicle) during the season.

# EDUCATION

The Education team has worked enthusiastically this season to provide courses which have expanded the skills and knowledge of our members. We started the season with the Youth SRC-Bronze Medallion Upgrade Intensive Course where the candidates set a high standard of physical expertise providing a positive spectacle for holiday makers during the October School holidays. Four more upgrades were run during the season which added 20 youth Bronze holders to our patrolling base. An adult Bronze course was conducted which contributed a committed and diversified skill set from new members to our patrols and water safety for Nippers and events.

We also concentrated on upskilling members' awards to further expand our patrol and support operations through running Club and Branch courses in SRC, First Aid, Advanced Resuscitation, IRB crew and drivers and RWC Operators to ensure that Cudgen Headland SLSLSC remains rescue ready.

This season we again continued development of volunteer professionalism through ongoing education in Skills Maintenance, which was run over many weekends in patrol groups, with a one-day traditional Skills Maintenance Day, where members had to book in to participate through the events calendar. Online modules, tourniquet training, resuscitation and rescue water work were diligently assessed with positive feedback from members. A separate IRB crew and SMIRBD Skills maintenance day was also held to make our first responders proficient. In fact, a large proportion of the season was spent upgrading TAFs, ARTS and our award members to the new SLSNSW competency requirements. We were also very fortunate to have 5 of our facilitators participate in the new SMPC course run at Ballina in September, which meant we could run this Branch Course in Kingscliff, Fingal and Ballina.

This season we have successfully encouraged more members to become part of our training team by applying for the Training Officers course. We have thus welcomed Erin Kill, Gavin Smith, Josh Heta and Rachael Robinson onto the Education Team. Each is at different stages of their probationary TAF award or mentorship. They each bring with them their individual personal expertise and skills in training IRB crew, SMIRBD, Bronze and SRC awards which has been a fabulous boost to Education generally within the Club. It is this expertise of our Educators that once again gained Cudgen the FNC Education Club of the Year Award.

I take this opportunity to thank our resolute, passionate and inspirational Education team- Greg Wood, Matthew Bell, Michael Kenny, David Field, Lachlan Field, Scott McCartney, David Rope, Dennis Eyre, Gary Raso, Erin Kill, Gavin Smith and our new training officers Rachael Robinson and Josh Heta, who volunteer their time to continue training courses so that our Club can grow and continue to attract members of all ages. It is the Education team of our facilitators, trainers and assessors that allows Cudgen to participate in competition, patrol and support operations which maintains our professional reputation within the Far North Coast Branch. Indeed, Education is the foundation of our Surf Life Saving movement providing the knowledge and skills needed to be a life saver.

# SURF SPORTS TREASURER'S REPORT

The 22-23 season returned to a thriving competitive environment at Surf Sports. A full program of events, managed by our Club Coach, included a training camp, Pool Rescue competitions, local NSW & Qld carnivals, Coolangatta Gold, Country, State and Aussie Championships plus the NSW Country Trans-Tasman Tri Series then rounding off with a fun Club Championships.

With the burden of Aussies being located in Perth, the costs to fund this busy program were substantial. Financial sponsorship was again gratefully received this year from Scandinavian Cones, Good Optical Services, the Old Boys. The Murwillumbah Truck Centre kindly donated funds to assist with the costs of transporting our container of watercraft and equipment to and from Perth.

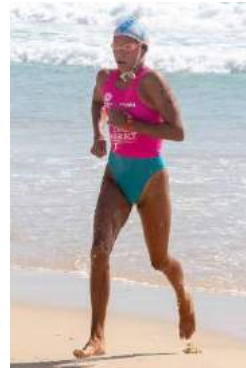

# DIRECTOR JAC

The 2022/23 season saw a changing of the guard with the JAC committee, with all but one executive volunteer being new this season.

We saw 289 registered Nippers join the club, a 6% decline from the prior year which was disappointing.

We continue to see strong numbers across our younger U6 & U7 age groups, with participation reflecting the growing community of Kingscliff and the importance parents place on beach/surf safety. We had 88 Nippers in these two age groups alone. Our U8 & U9 age groups had 90 Nippers indicating retention levels at this age bracket is strong. Where we saw some challenges was in the U10 & U11s age groups where we saw a more significant decline with only 56 across these two groups.

*“The strategic plan set in place two years ago has 3 pillars with which we will continue to track our progress in seasons ahead (please see the Strategic Plan below).”*

The first of these pillars is **Sustainability**, which is anchored by a desire to grow our Nipper population, increase yearly retention, and progress our Nipper parent engagement, resulting in increased water safety, beach coordinators to assist age managers, and integrated training resources so as we can advance our education programs.

The approach to Sunday Nippers continued to focus on it being about creating lifesavers of the future, with attention being directed towards participation and engagement. We did see 96 Nippers not return from last year, and we do need to actively understand these reasons to allow for future planning, along with seeking feedback from our parents on what worked/didn't work.

We continue to build on our water safety numbers but have some further progress here to get to our target.

Following feedback received last year for the need for some dedicated trainers to assist in developing skills within our younger age groups, Phil Klein stepped into our assist our younger U8 age group. This year we able to deliver some additional education resources such as a CPR course, The KaMana workshop about empowering the next generation of female athletes to build confidence and reach their potential, and the U13 Fingal sleepover.

We continued to build on our community engagement with the Clean Up Australia, Albatrose Nippers engagement and Turtlewatch NSW and Dolphin Research Australia joining us to run

programs. Thank you to Sarah Whitrod for bringing these opportunities to life.

We updated the Nippers handbook this year and ensured that all new Nippers received this handbook to help with orientation around what to expect at Nippers. Unfortunately, we didn't get around to the Nipper Parent social gathering at the commencement of the year. We will plan for more parent engagement in the next season.

The second Pillar is **Pathways**. Our goal here is to retain 75% of our U14's within the club, ensuring that they have clear pathways identified, and are not lost to SLS. In addition, we want 90% of our U13's to complete their SRC, with a further 75% of those to go on and complete their Bronze.

The majority of our U14's completed their SRC in the first part of the year – thanks to the support of the education team and the efforts of Carsten and Erin to make sure everyone had the opportunity to get it done. It has been so great to see all our U14's join patrols and commence their patrolling journey during the season.

With the leadership of Erin Kill, the club initiated a Youth Group in the club to aid the ongoing engagement of those in the 15-17 age groups. The common room looks great and is a great space for our kids to hang out.

The last Pillar is **Sport**. Here we wanted to retain the NSW Country Championship title, and at the State Titles finish Top 10 with 100 points, ending up as the leading country club.

To Coach George – the progress our Nippers continue to make as competitors and people is a testament to the many hours that you have put in. On behalf of everyone, thank you for the effort, energy, sacrifice and time that you have put in. Thanks also goes to Phil for once again giving so much of his time and experience to get the kids fired up and ready to go, and to Adam for helping our Beach competitors continue to progress. To Ross Day, thank you for your mentoring and support of our kids and sharing your immense experience.

On the results side – we only just missed our objectives. We unfortunately lost the Country Championships title to Warilla Barrack Point by 26 points. Our juniors however did manage to take home the points. We knew they were coming after our title so next year will need to take it back!

The unity, support and comradery was great to see, and something I hope we draw on in years to come. We also had some outstanding efforts across the 3 days at Forster, with a heap of finalists and many medals.

At State Champs our junior team came 11<sup>th</sup> with 90 points and was the number one country club. It was our best State Championships in terms of how many kids made finals and achieved results in the top 6. We took home 14 medals. We can see the result of the training paying off.

With Aussie's left for our U13-U15 age groups, we wish our Nippers the best of luck in Perth.

I'd like to thank all our Sponsors. The Glass Lab have for several years supported our raffle (the primary fund raiser for the club), and we're super thankful to Adam Wessel for the ongoing support. Thank you to Marni Tsula and Miimis for the Nippers of the week vouchers and to Tango Gelato & Tropical Fruit World for their support of the Cudgen Classic.

I'd like to thank everyone who has contributed to the season. We are a club that operates off the contribution of volunteer parents, and we're so lucky to have you all.

Firstly, to our parents, thank you for taking time out of your Sunday morning to bring your kids down to Nippers and supporting their development and surf awareness. Thank you for those that get their kids down to training and to the carnivals. It is a big commitment, and we really appreciate it. We are not only building our surf lifesavers of the future, but our community.

Thank you to our Age Managers – you're an amazing group of people and I'm thankful for all the time you give for the benefit of so many.

To the Water Safety Team, thanks for the hours at training, on Sundays and Carnivals. Our Nippers cannot get in the water without you – so thank you. To Tom, thank you for making sure everyone in the water was so well managed. To our Officials – New and Old – thanks for taking on so much at carnivals to allow our kids to compete – without you there is no carnival, so thank you. A big shout out to Maree for managing our officials and organising all the sign on sheets each week.

Clare George has done a phenomenal job with our merchandise again – thank you so much Clare

To Shane Preston and Ben Allsopp who are the first here every Sunday to set up, a big thank you. You guys have been rocks this year!

I'd like to pay particular thanks to head chef Dan and Karen Allsopp and Nat Ewington for keeping the BBQ humming all year. It's been a massive effort of the years, thank you for your commitment.

I'd really like to recognise the committee – Kim, Deb, Nick, Maree, Tom, Sarah, Ben & Shane – all your efforts are very much appreciated, and we look forward to building on what we have started this year.

Thanks to Robyn for her wonderful photos every year, so nice to have these memories as our kids complete their journey with the club.

Highlighting those groups and individuals by no means diminishes the hard work from so many others across the club – thank you to everyone who has contributed to the season. Given we had several vacant roles on this year's committee, it will be great to see all the roles filled this year so we can share the load.

As a club we greatly appreciate the time from so many volunteers and the contribution of our sponsors – it's what makes Cudgen such a great club. For us to deliver the program we would like for our Nippers – we need continued involvement from parents. Please put your hand up to take on some of the roles we have available today, we will have plenty of help and mentoring to support you – and it's a terrific thing to be giving back to the community and the club.

## *Doug Paddon* - Bronze Medallion No. Q2771 – 15/1/1961



It is with much sadness that we farewell Gold Card member Doug Paddon 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2023.

Doug joined Cudgen Headland SLSC at around 14 years of age when the original clubhouse was still standing. He became a passionate Boatie member (as was his father Harold Paddon) and was also a Boat Sweep for many years and enjoyed attending surf carnivals on the Far North Coast. Doug was involved in the construction of the new clubhouse which opened in 1964 and later became a Gold Card member in the 90's when members were called up to assist with another club upgrade which involved the removal of the squash courts to create what is now our Bistro space.

Doug was a proud patroller and was involved in many rescues over the years. This is an excerpt from a newspaper article on one of those occasions. "A Cudgen Headland surf lifesaver, Doug Paddon, paddled almost a mile to rescue a Brisbane skin diver

and his woman companion who were being swept out to sea on their ski off Kingscliff yesterday. When they realised the two were trying to make the beach Doug went out on a ski, after reaching the couple he took the girl onto his ski and guided the man's ski into the beach."

Doug will also be remembered as the "barefoot" Cudgen farmer who became a beloved community icon largely because of his self-serve trailer on Tweed Coast road, known as Doug's Cow (because he used to "feed" it during the day, and "milk" it at night with his takings). The trailer was always stocked with mountains of fresh Cudgen sweet potatoes, wonderful juicy corn and over the Christmas period his tasty watermelons. Doug was involved in many other community organisations as well, he was the Captain of the Cudgen Bush Fire Brigade for many years and was also the President of the Tweed Fruit and Vegetable Growers Association.

Doug's contributions to not just our Surf Club but to our whole community are to be commended, and he will be sorely missed by many, may he Rest in Peace.

Michelle worked as a lifeguard with Tweed Shire Council back in the 80's and had a fierce love of the ocean.

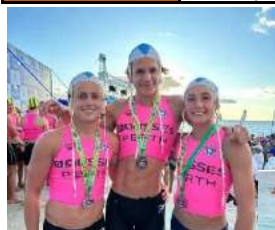

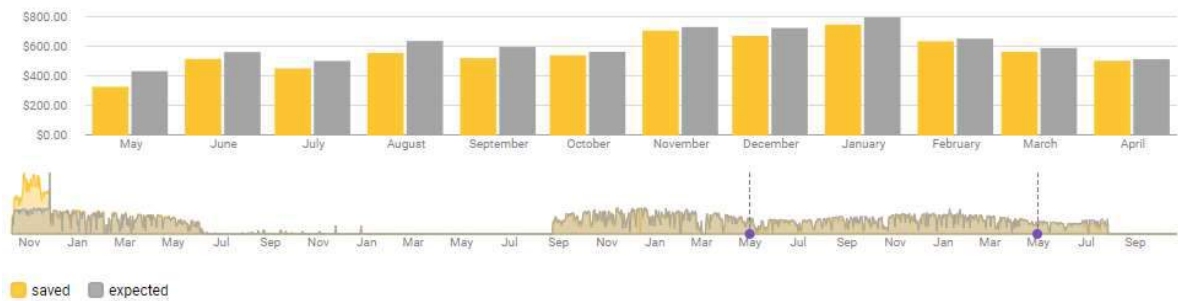


## CUDGEN HEADLAND SLSC AND THE ENVIRONMENT
